Dear Families,

We were notified this afternoon of two individuals who tested positive for COVID-19 (Coronavirus). We have been in communication with the Kenosha County Health Department and they have provided guidance on our every step. More specifically, the Health Department has assisted our district with the contact tracing procedures and protocols. The individuals have not been in attendance at school this week. Following specific contact tracing procedures, it has been determined that **no students or staff** will need to quarantine based on these positive tests.

Although no close contacts have been identified at school, please monitor your student and family members for any COVID symptoms including but not limited to: fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, fatigue, headaches, etc. If you do become symptomatic, please call your healthcare provider to alert them of the situation. Information related to the positive person and their test results is confidential and will not be shared with others without the person's consent. Inappropriate use of this information is a violation of the person's privacy under law outlined in the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act.

The purpose of this letter is strictly to help prevent the further spread of the COVID-19 virus in our community by providing education and information to our stakeholders. The health and safety of the families and our community is our priority. We are continuing to assess this situation, work alongside the health department, and encourage you to follow any isolation/quarantine guidelines that are given to you by the health department. We will continue our best efforts to protect and support our students and families during this time.
