

Activities of the Foundation

The Foundation provides a conduit for funding of special projects for the high school where donors seek a tax deductible means of contributing. Such funding does not impact school financial formulas of state aid while providing a means of direct support to the school for its educational and extra-curricular activities.

The Foundation has been accumulating funds for the awarding of scholarships to graduating seniors of the high school.

This is an area that needs significant funding in order to sustain annual awards and not spend down the contributed principal.

History

Westosha Central High School Foundation was organized in the fall of 2004 by community volunteers to raise funds for new bleachers. The fundraising was successful and the bleachers were installed in time for the 2005 football season. The bleachers have now been relocated to the new stadium where they serve as visitor bleachers. Community organizers, with approval from the School Board, formed a not for profit corporation that is today the Foundation.

The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) not for profit public charity and is eligible to receive tax deductible donations. The Foundation is listed in the Cumulative List of Organizations described in Section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code.

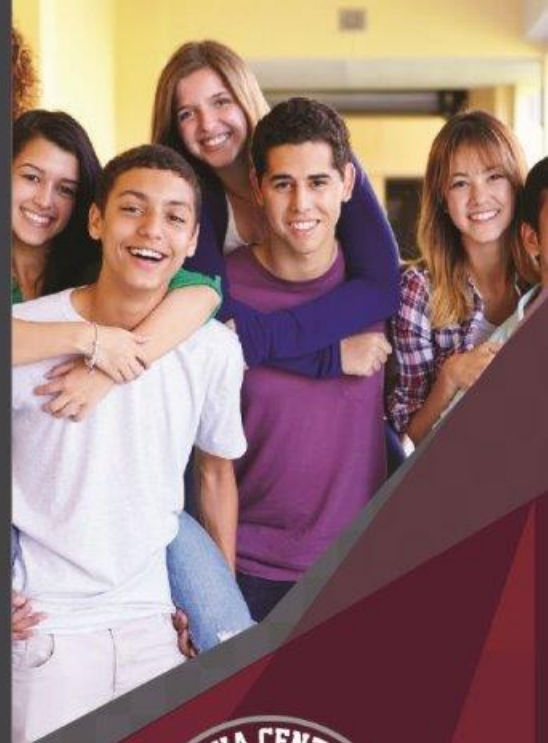
About Central High School
