Forms can either be picked up at Central High School or printed from the school website at www.westosha.k12.wi.us

All registration will be done by random lottery. Students will be scheduled as their registration form is drawn. It is recommended that siblings register in the same envelope.

Please do not send fees in with registration forms. A billing statement will be mailed home once schedules are finalized.

Non-Resident Students: Official acceptance to Central High School will be determined by the School Board in May.

Summer Session Timeline:

January 24 - Summer School forms will be mailed home with report cards.

February 15 - Last date that registration materials will be accepted by Sheree Pfeuffer, in the guidance office.

Envelopes must be postmarked or delivered to CHS no later than 3:00 p.m. on Feb. 15.

March 15 - Preliminary Schedules and appropriate fees will be mailed.

May 24 - Final Schedules and Bus Routes will be mailed.

May 31 - The deadline for parents to drop classes without incurring a \$25 administrative drop fee per class.

June 24 - Summer Session begins.

July 3 - July 5 – No School (Wednesday-Friday)

August 1 - Last Day/ Final Exams (Thursday)

Students who would like to change the date of their final exam need to fill out the necessary forms and get teacher and administrative approval before final exam week. Contact Mr. Leavy for more information.

Important Notes:

- All summer class offerings are tentative depending on student enrollment and staffing.
- Special Education services are only provided if a student's IEP outlines extended year. Please speak to your child's case manager for clarification.

Transportation:

Bussing will be available on a modified route, availability basis. Students electing to take the bus to summer session must be enrolled in two sessions, attending class from 7:00 a.m. to 12:25 p.m. each day.

Grading Policy:

Students dropping a summer course after the first 5 days of instruction will result in a grade of WF (withdraw/fail). The WF grade factors into GPA calculation equivalent to a grade of "F".

Refund Policy:

If a course requires a fee, a full refund will be made if the course is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. Student initiated course drops after May 31, 2019, will result in a \$25 administrative fee per course. This includes students dropped from a course for attendance issues.
