## APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Fill out a practice application:** Photocopy the application and use the copy to write a draft. Once you have fine-tuned your answers, type them neatly on the original.
- **Pay attention to detail:** Be careful, omitting information or making a careless error can cost you.
- **Be concise, but creative:** Judges will be impressed by what you write, not how much you write.
- **Do the math:** If an application asks for your family's income, expected college expenses or other figures, make sure those numbers are correct.
- **Recommendation Letters:** Give them a summary of your achievements, awards, activities and goals. Include information about the scholarship and its sponsor. Ask that they address their letter to the specific scholarship committee.
